## CAPE CHARLES' HALLOWEEN ACTIVITIES

**Friday, 10/25:** The Halloween activities kick off Friday night with the showing of *Hocus Pocus*. Due to the uncertainty of the weather and the expected drop in temperatures, the movie will be shown at the Palace Theatre beginning at 6:30 PM. The Palace Theatre will have snacks and beverages available for sale.

**Saturday, 10/26:** All Saturday activities will be held at the Cape Charles Harbor.

- **1:00 PM – 3:00 PM: Trunk-or-Treat.** Trunk-or-Treating, it is a safe and family-friendly community event where children can trick-or-treat from the trunks of cars. It's often called Halloween tail-gating. The general theme is that everyone will come dressed in costumes and the cars will be decorated to show the Halloween spirit and pass out candy.

Pre-register your car:

We are asking that all cars pre-register. If you are interested in participating, please email [Jen Lewis](#) to reserve your spot. Jen will provide you with a car registration number. On Saturday, 10/26, please plan to arrive around 12:30 PM. The children will begin Trunk-or-Treating at 1:00 PM. All cars are responsible for providing their own candy. We anticipate there to be around 100 children participating.

- **3:00 PM – 6:00 PM: Pumpkin Carving Contest at the Shanty**
- **6:00 PM – 9:00 PM: Haunted Harbor.** Once darkness settles in the Harbor will transform into a spooky Haunted Harbor! Parents are encouraged to evaluate the area before admitting their children. There will be ghosts and goblins around every corner and may not be enjoyed by little ones. If little ones decide to join the ghosts and goblins, they must be accompanied by an adult at all times.

**Thursday, 10/31:** The Town will observe Halloween trick-or-treating on Thursday, 10/31. The Town curfew that evening is 8:00 PM for all individuals under the age of 18. The curfew will be strictly enforced. Masks are not permitted on youth over the age of 12.
