MAYOR PROTO TO HOLD TOWN HALL MEETING AND REGULAR "OFFICE HOURS"

Mayor Proto has scheduled a Town Hall meeting for Saturday, September 13, 2014, from 1:00 PM to 3:00 PM at the Cape Charles Civic Center located at 500 Tazewell Avenue (the former library building). He will update the Town's citizens on a variety of topics and citizens will be given an opportunity to voice their concerns and ask questions.

The Mayor will also be holding regular "Office Hours" on the second and fourth Tuesdays of each month at the Civic Center. The hours will be from 2:00 PM to 4:00 PM on the second Tuesdays, and from 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM on the fourth Tuesdays in order to accommodate retirees and those that work during the days. Mayor Proto will be available during those times to meet with citizens regarding their concerns.
