At 6:00 p.m. Mayor Dora Sullivan, having established a quorum, called to order the Public Hearing of the Town Council. In addition to Mayor Sullivan, present were Vice Mayor Bannon, Councilmen Godwin and Sullivan, and Councilwoman Natali. Councilmen Bennett and Wendell were not in attendance. Also in attendance were Town Manager Heather Arcos, Treasurer Kim Coates, Harbor Master Smitty Dize and Town Clerk Libby Hume. There were 4 members of the public in attendance.

Mayor Sullivan announced that the evening's Public Hearing was to hear public comment regarding the granting of easements on portions of tax parcel 83A3-10 on the harbor bottom to extend 100' west of tax parcel 83A3-12 and 70' north of tax parcel 83A3-19 in connection with establishing and operating a vessel repair business on adjoining parcels.
