



TOWN COUNCIL
Executive Session
Town Hall
November 12, 2009
6:00 p.m.

At approximately 6:07 p.m. Vice Mayor Chris Bannon called to order the Executive Session of the Town Council. In addition to Vice Mayor Bannon, present were Councilmen Bennett, Elliott and Veber. Councilman Burdiss had recused himself and was not in attendance. Mayor Sullivan and Councilman Evans were not in attendance. Also in attendance were Town Manager Heather Arcos and Town Planner Tom Bonadeo.

Councilman Veber stated that he would participate in the meetings regarding the Cape Charles Christian School but would not vote on the issue since he has two grandchildren attending the school. Councilman Elliott added that he also had a grandchild attending the school.

Motion made by Councilman Veber, seconded by Councilman Bennett and unanimously approved to go into Closed Session in accordance with Section 2.2-3711-A of the Code of Virginia of 1950, as amended for the purpose of:

Paragraph 3: Discussion or consideration of the acquisition of real property for a public purpose, or of the disposition of publicly held real property, where discussion in an open meeting would adversely affect the bargaining position or negotiating strategy of the public body.

Specifically: Cape Charles Christian School

Motion made by Councilman Bennett, seconded by Councilman Veber and unanimously approved to return to Open Session.

Motion to certify to the best of each member's knowledge (i) only public business matters lawfully exempted from open meeting requirements under this chapter and (ii) only such public business matters as were identified in the motion by which the closed meeting was convened were heard, discussed or considered in the meeting by the public body. Roll call vote: Bannon, yes; Bennett, yes; Elliott, yes; Veber, yes.

Motion made by Councilman Bannon, seconded by Councilman Bennett and unanimously approved to adjourn the Town Council Executive Session.
