Mr. Charles Dumouchelle, President of the Northampton County Anglers Club, addressed the Town Council stating his concern regarding the expansion of the "No Wake Zone" adding that it would be nearly impossible to navigate a boat into the Harbor going 3 MPH against a strong northwest wind. Mr. Dumouchelle then read a statement from the Northampton County Anglers Club in opposition to the extended "No Wake Zone." (See attached)
